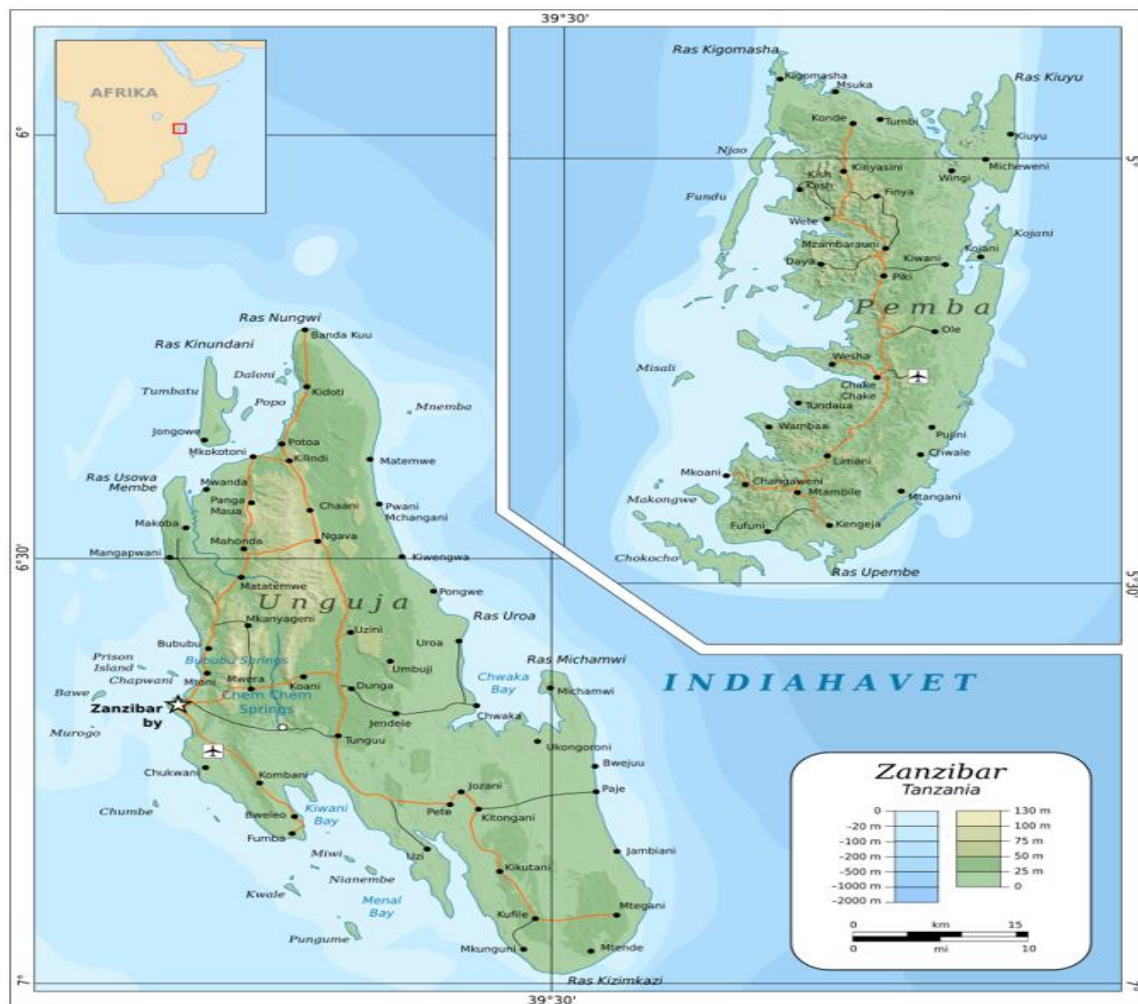


Figure 0-1: Location map of Zanzibar

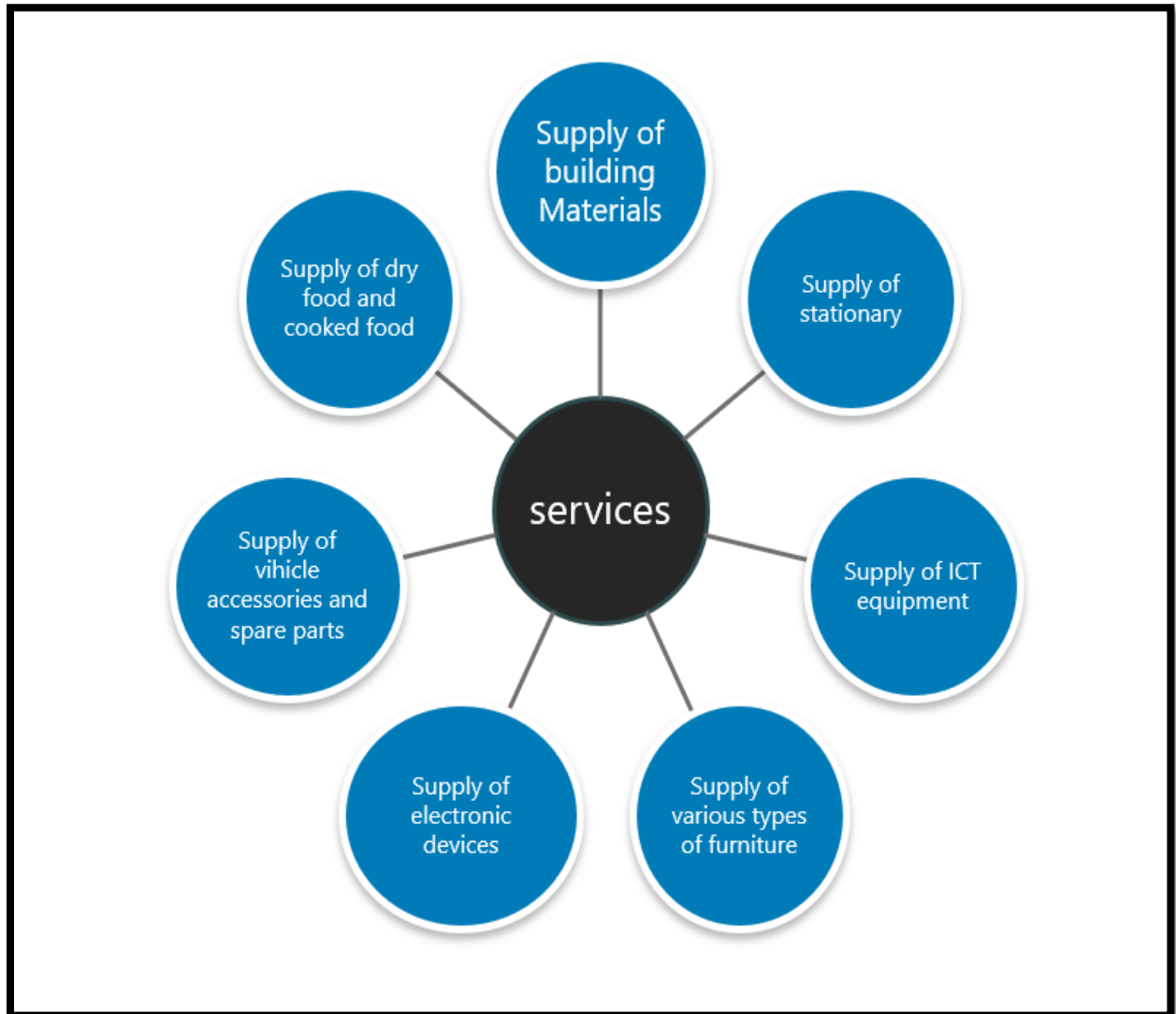


Figure 2-1: Tazkiya Company Limited services

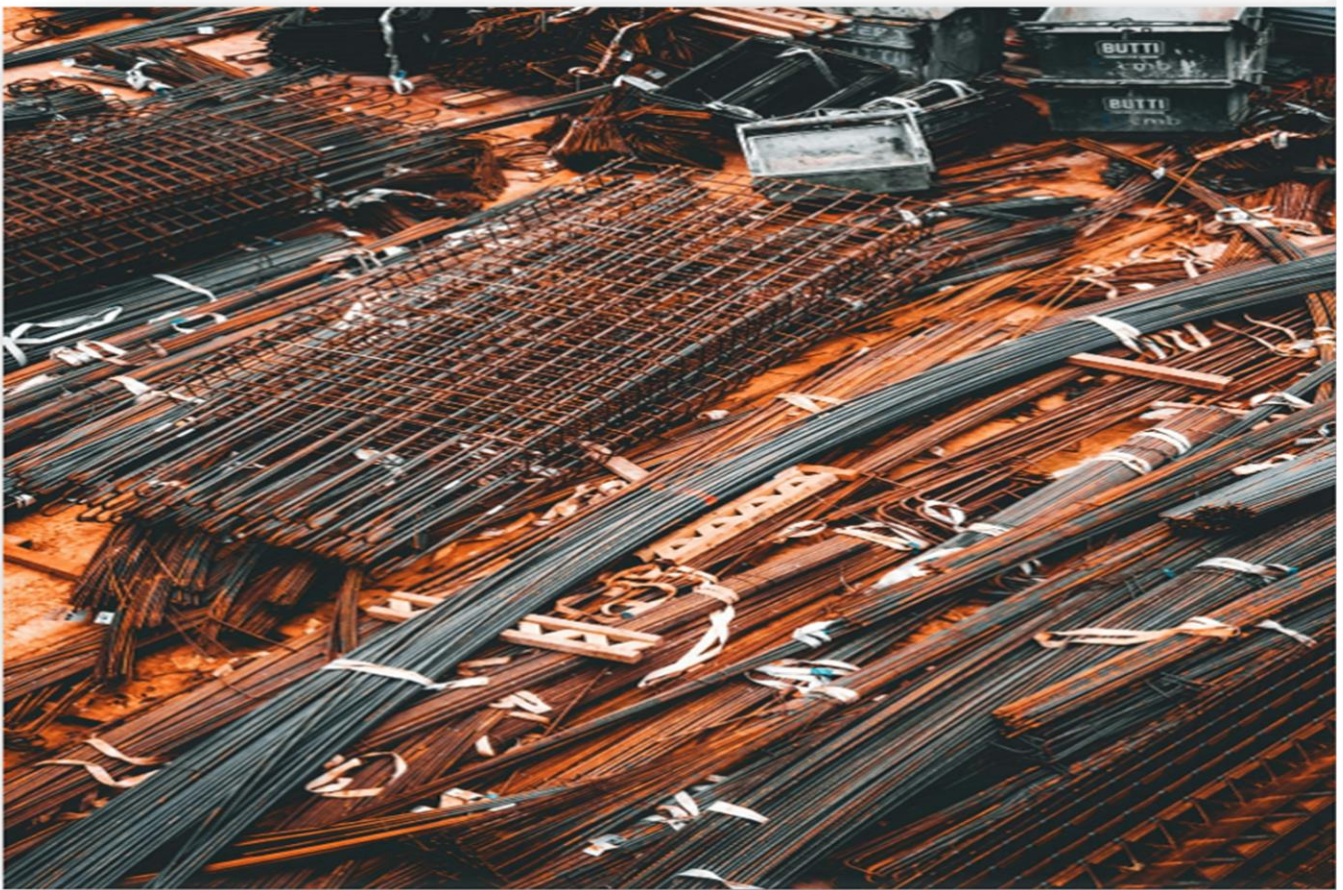


Figure 2-2: Sample of supplied building materials by us

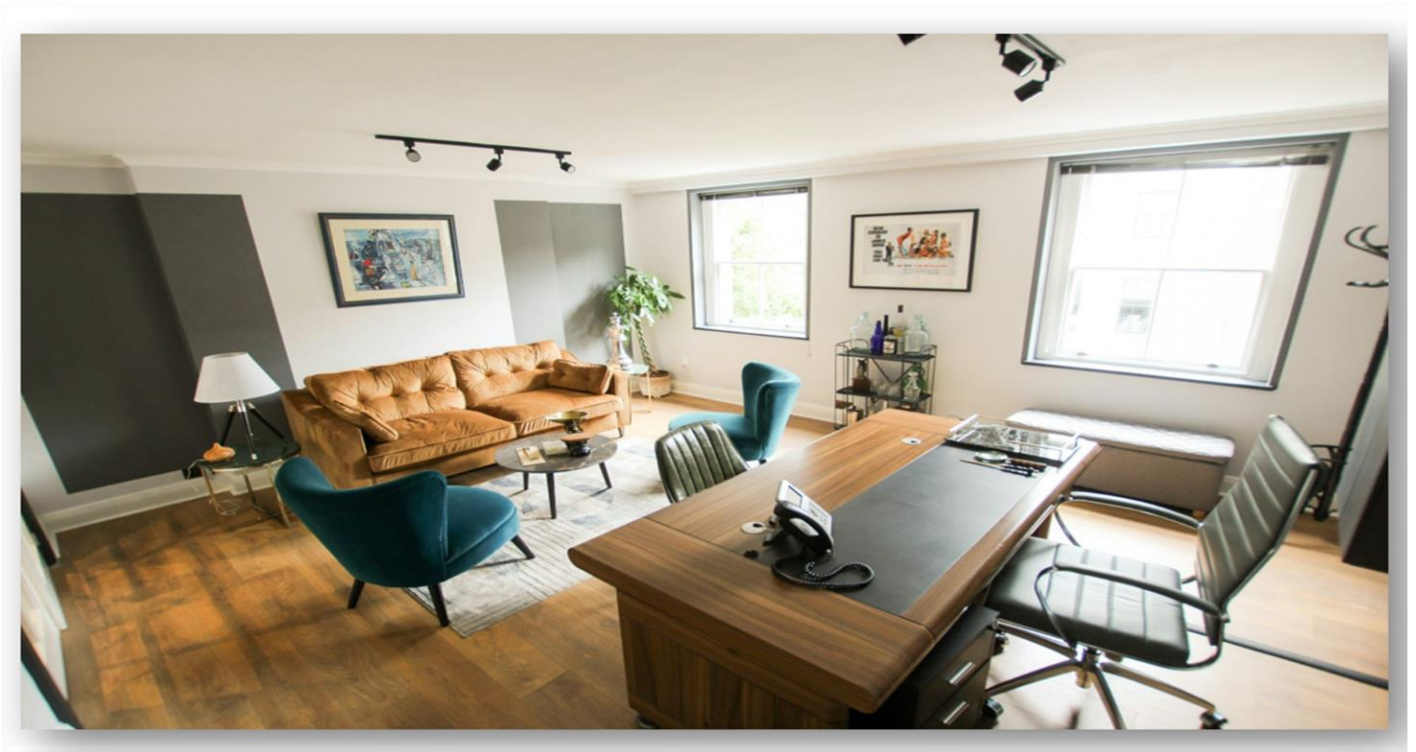


Figure 2-8: Sample of the office furniture supplied by TCL

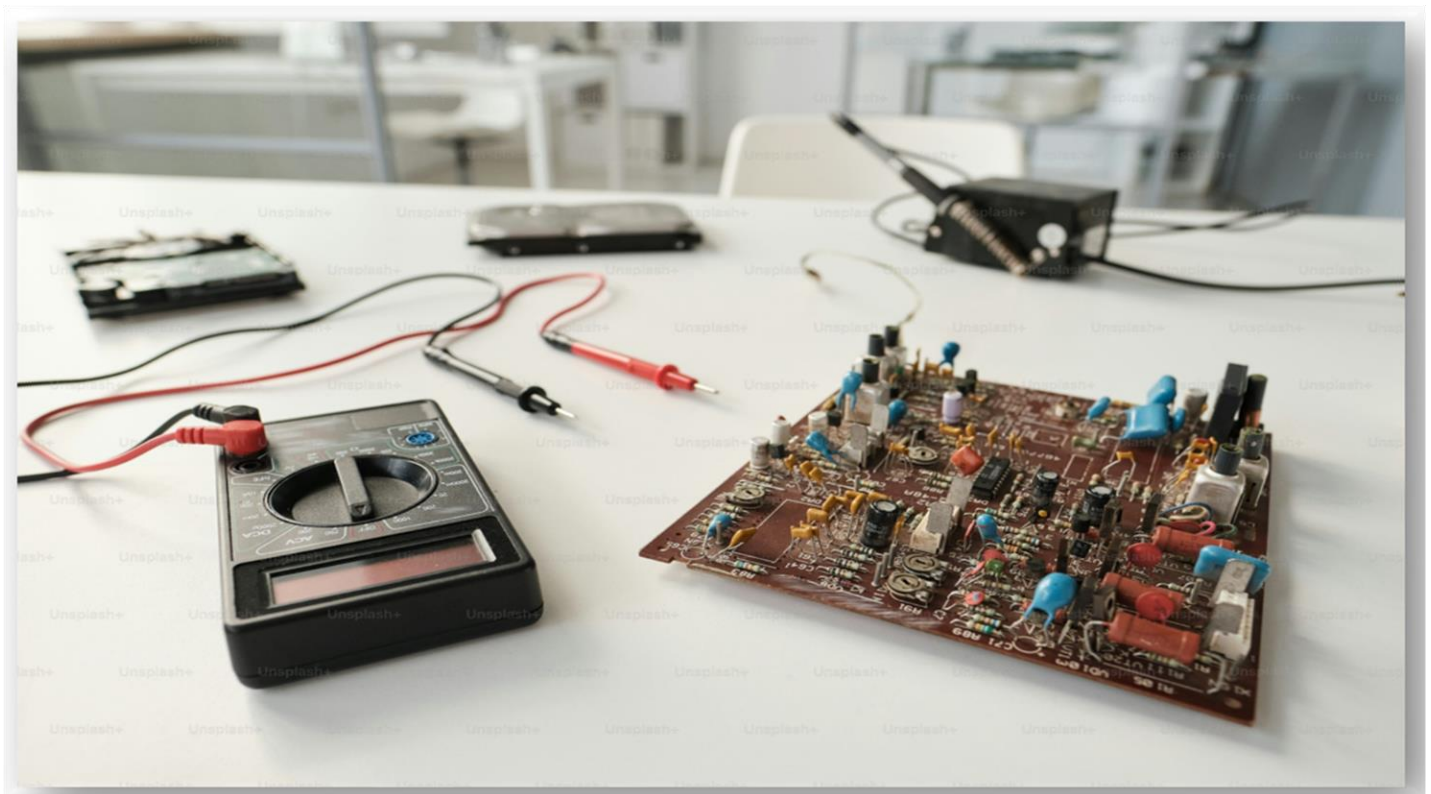


Figure 2-9: Electronic devices

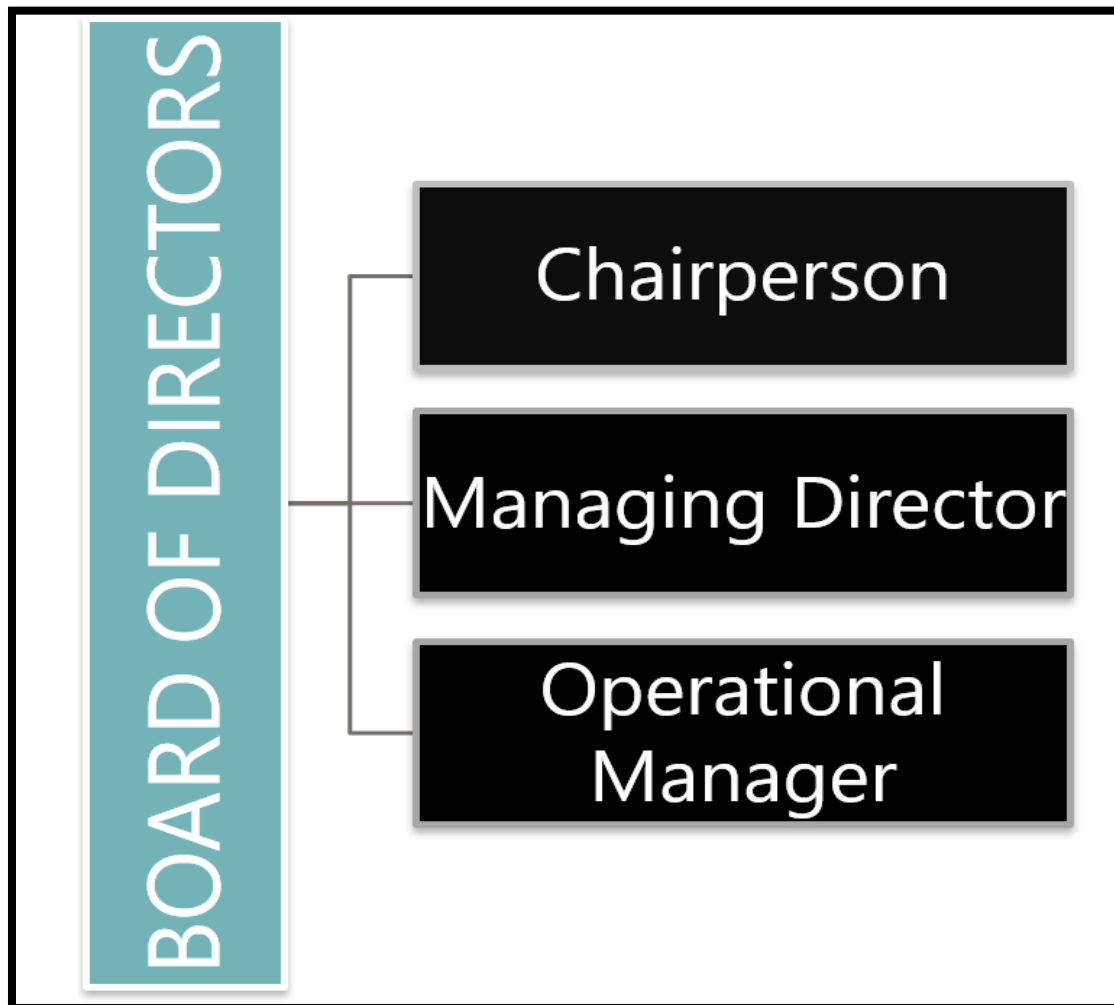


Figure 3-1: Management and organization structure

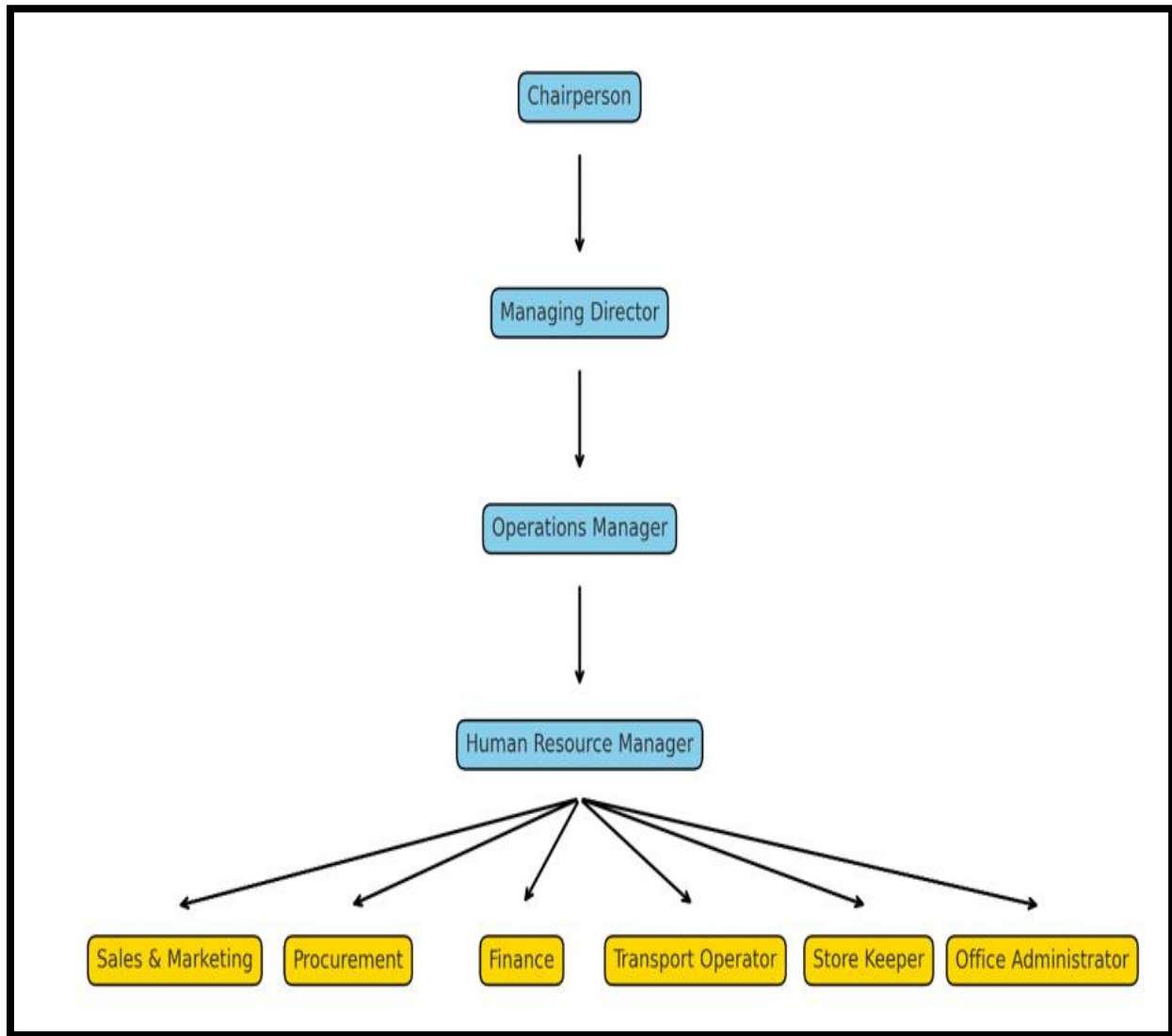


Figure 3-2: Leadership chain

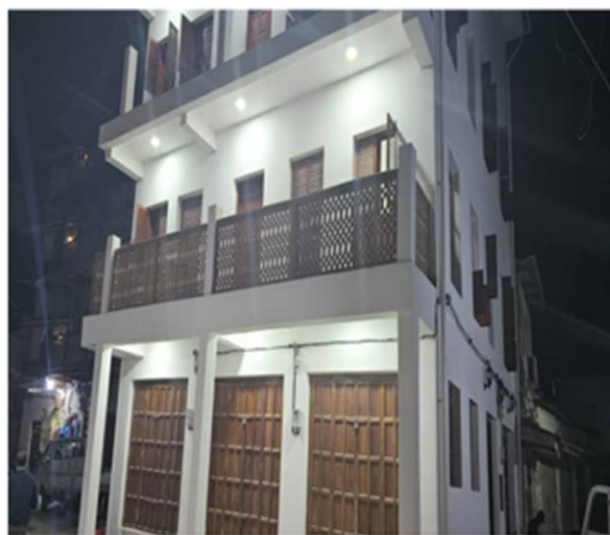
Figure 5-2: Server equipment supplied to Zanzibar Housing Corporation (ZHC) to enhance their IT infrastructure and network operations.

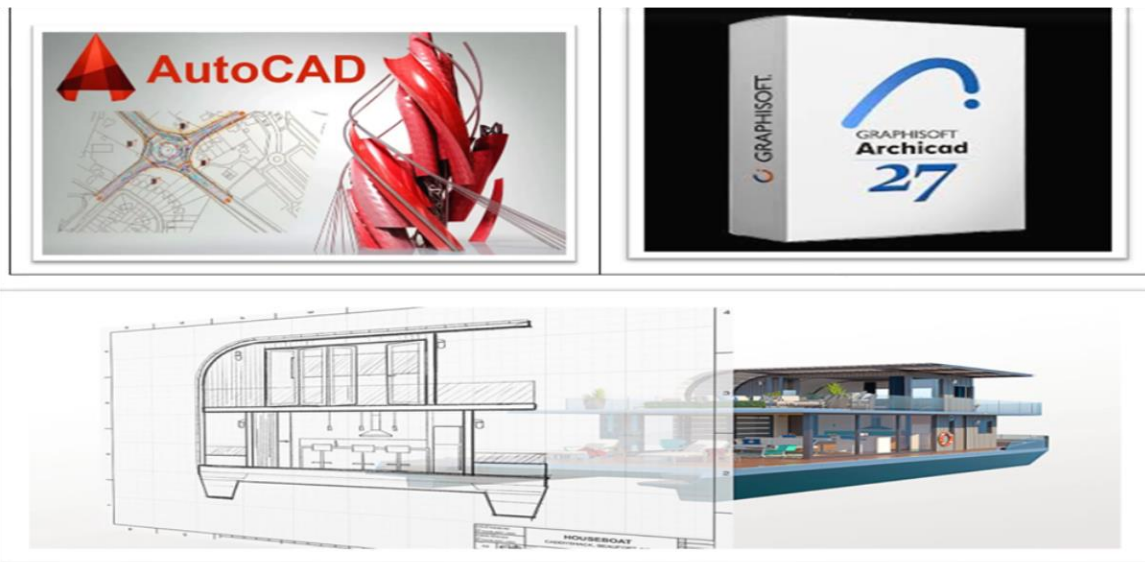


Figure 5-5: Software installed at ZECO

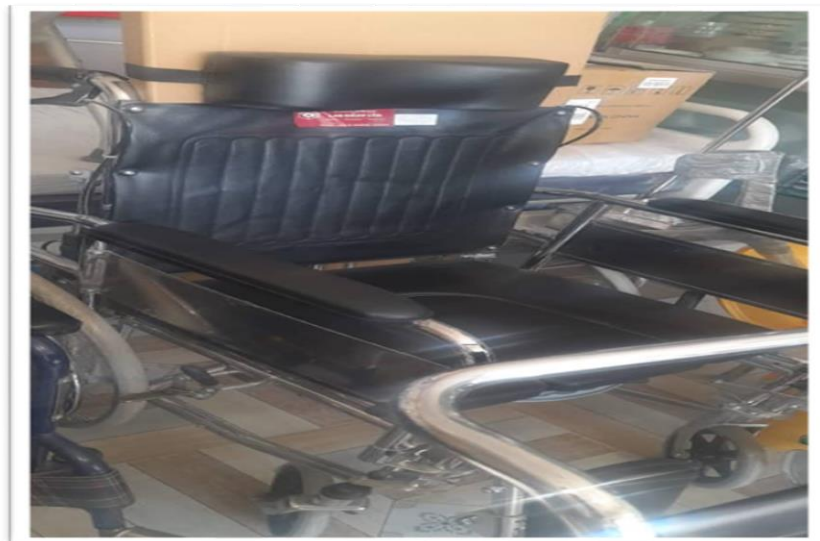


Figure 5-7: Wheelchair supplied to the Vice president's Office by Tazkiya

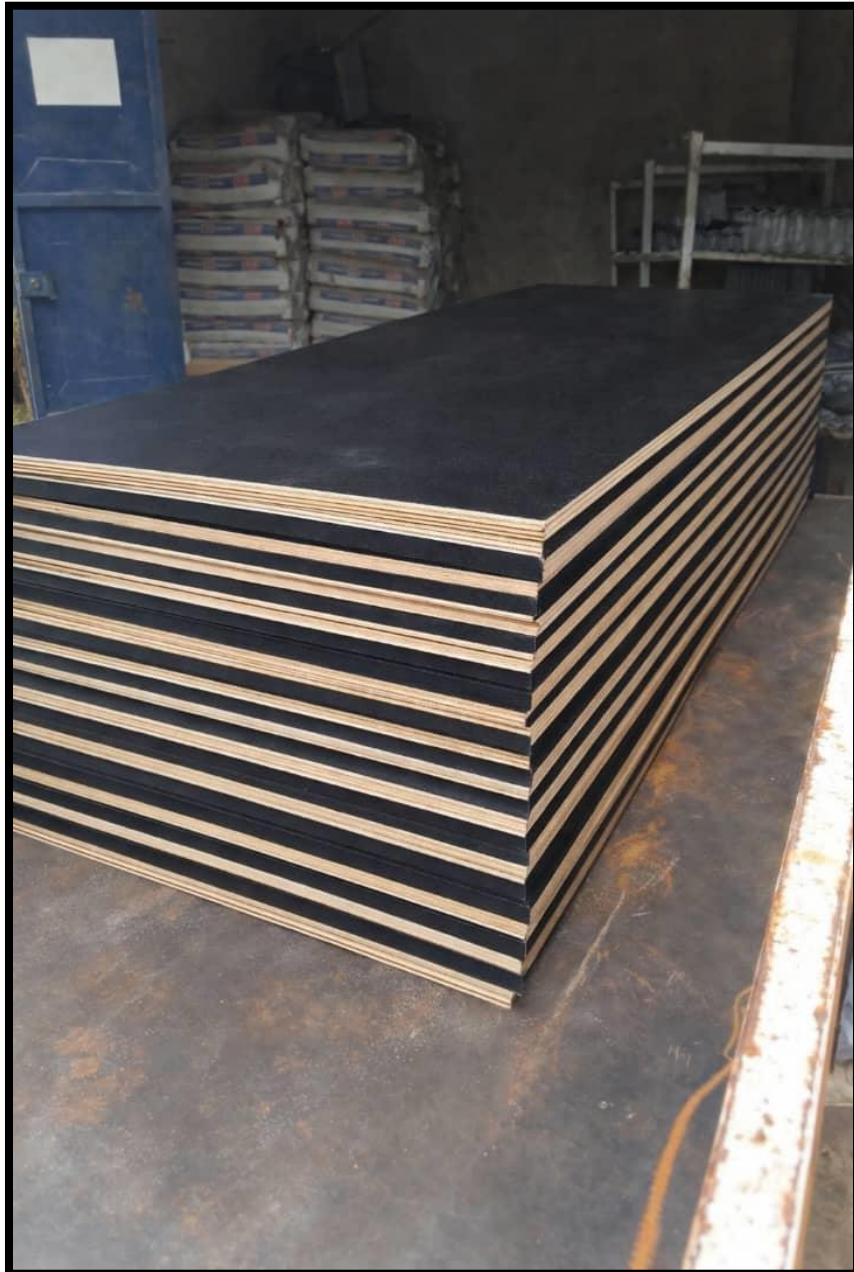

This initiative demonstrates the company's commitment to sustainable agricultural development, food production, and business diversification while contributing to local food security and economic growth.



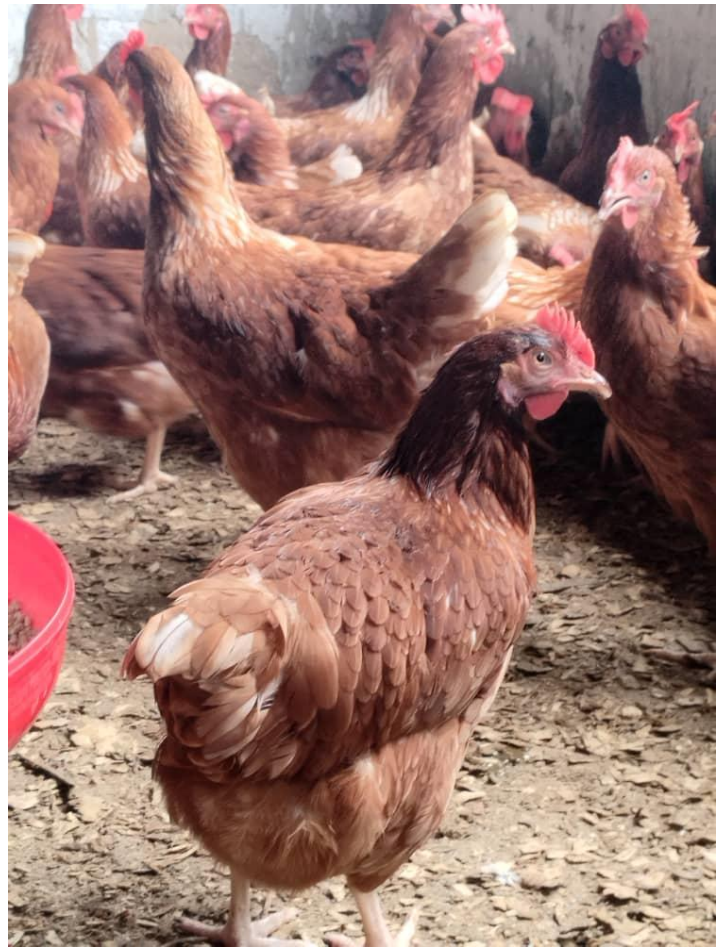


Figure 0-1: Poultry farming initiative by Tazkiya Company Limited

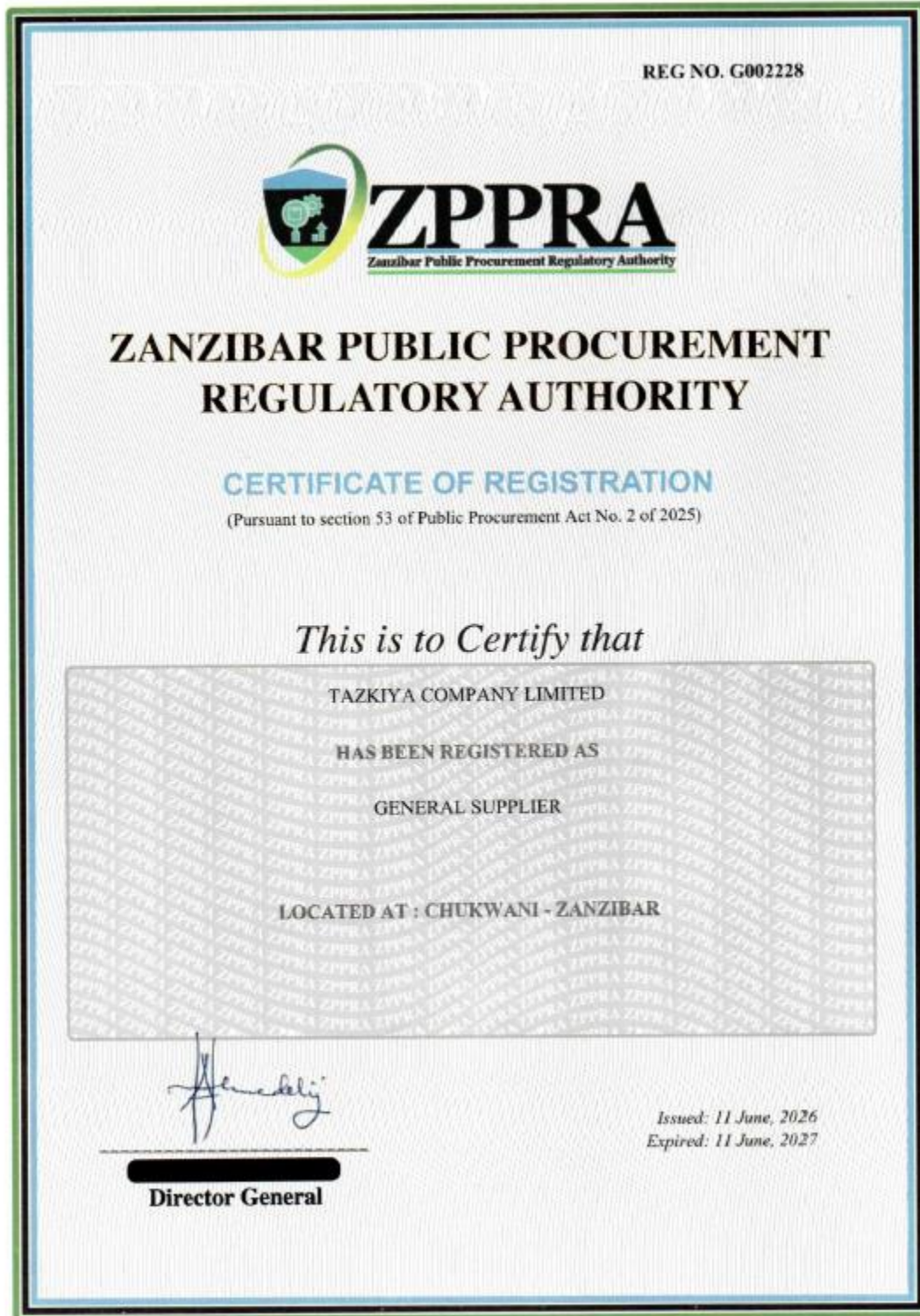


Figure 0-1: Certificate of registration for the Tazkiya Company limited

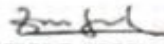

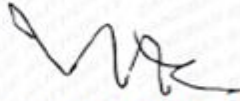

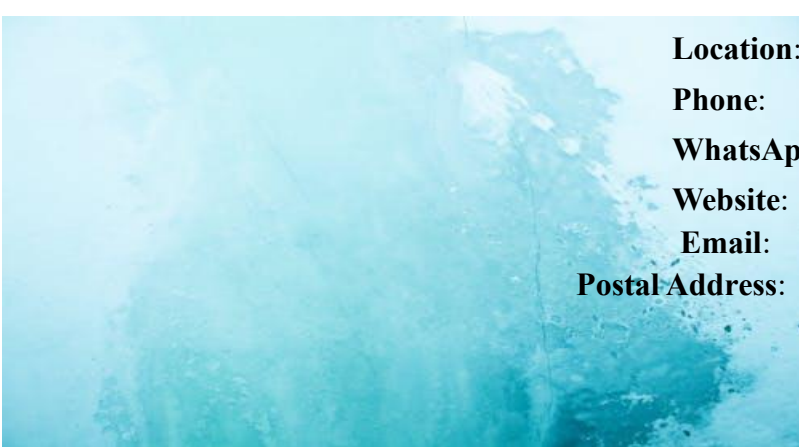
